Celebrating 70 Years with Driver Compensation Upgrades + Mack Anthem Tractors

We are celebrating and commemorating throughout 2018, but this 70th Anniversary is just as much about the future as it is the past. Highway Transport's professional system truck drivers are excited about the arrival —throughout spring & summer— of 75 of the newest model of Mack Trucks being added to our fleet. The name of the model is *Anthem*. Highway's first Anthem rolled onto the Knoxville yard on April 12, 2018.

As a company, we are not only reflecting on 70 years with the launch of a special commemorative video but also experiencing growth and higher pay. The future plan is to increase business throughout the southeastern US. Specifically, expansion is expected to take place surrounding Highway's Geismar service center.

Marshall Franklin, President & CFO, says "Early 2018 has been a time of growth and demand. Specialty chemical companies are demanding that we expand our 2018-2019 capacity,

particularly throughout the southeastern corridor of the U.S. where many chemical manufacturers are expanding their facilities."

Director of Linehaul & Recruiting, Joe Sheldon says, "As our new video illustrates, Highway Transport chemical tanker truck drivers are an elite class of truck driver with a

superior level of skill. They are everyday heroes with the deepest concern for others...the safest fleet on the road. System drivers are at the heart of Highway's growth plan. The new Mack Anthems will be allocated to system drivers. Drivers who are willing to run

Tax free, is not reported on Form W-2 and is not subject to income or employment taxes.

throughout Highway Transport's system will be greatly rewarded. This includes:

- a pay upgrade
- a new per diem package
- additional incentive pay for system drivers who stay with Highway Transport

With an intense focus on safety, Highway Transport's 70year chemical tanker legacy allows us to offer superior pay and benefits packages to CDL drivers with chemical tanker experience and HazMat certification."

Vice President of Safety, Rick Lusby adds, "Major chemical companies ask us to extend our capacity, but what gives Highway an edge over the competition... is that we can achieve this growth while maintaining an impeccable safety record."



I am excited to announce three updates to our driver pay package.

First We are increasing all mileage scales by an average of 4.5%. Also, we are increasing hourly detention and loads below 150 miles rates by \$1 per hour. This


increase will be effective April 30th.

Second We are introducing a Per Diem program available to all drivers. This program will allow you to have \$63 of your daily pay become nontaxable when you are away from home. Drivers "net" or "take home" pay will be higher utilizing this plan. This program is the only way drivers will be able to have a tax advantage for their overnight stays in 2018 and the future. Drivers' ability to deduct this amount on their tax returns is not part of the new federal tax laws of the Unites States. There will be separate announcements with more details about this plan. The Per Diem is effective May 7th.

Third We are introducing a system driver premium of 5% of pay. This reflects our desire to reward the additional flexibility and sacrifice made by the system driver fleet who stay away from home for weeks at a time. The 5% of gross pay will be paid quarterly, at the end of the following quarter, to all system drivers who continue to work for Highway in the system fleet. There will be a separate announcement to the system drivers with more detailed information. The premium is effective for Highway's 2nd quarter which we are currently in, so the first payment of this premium will be at the end of the 3rd quarter.

I am grateful for the ability to reward everyone's hard work and dedication. We have the best drivers in the industry and we will continue to strive to reward you for your dedication to doing the best job possible.

CSA Scores

These numbers are very important to every employee at Highway Transport, as the numbers are shared with all of our customers, which can help gain more business opportunities for the company. Steve Kitts, Vice President of Sales, states the CSA scores are a vital tool the sales force uses on a weekly basis to share with our customers. This demonstrates Highway Transport's commitment to the safety of our employees, families, and the motoring public.

What does CSA stand for? Compliance, Safety, Accountability.

Where do CSA numbers come from? Safety data is collected from roadside inspections, crash reports, investigation results and registration details. All this data is then made available on the FMCSA's Safety Management System (SMS) website, which is updated on a monthly basis.

What's a good score? The lower the score, the better. If you receive 65 percent or greater in any of the seven categories, you're likely to get a letter from the FMCSA and may undergo further scrutiny. Because hazmat carriers can pose a greater danger to roadways, they must maintain scores below 60 percent to prevent investigations.



Drivers Remember... doing a thorough Pre-Trip inspection is key to being safe, and you have a moral obligation to yourself, your family, our customers, and the motoring public to operate your CMV in a safe and professional manner every day.



At Highway Transport, because we deliver specialty chemicals, we personalize this using the acronym QDDMS. The letters "Q-D-D-M-S" stand for Quality Driven Delivery Management System. Highway's development of QDDMS is a structured way for everyone at the company to not only meet but exceed the requirements of Responsible Care® . To ensure that our company adheres to all Responsible Care® requirements, Highway Transport assembled and trained a team of internal auditors.

Exposure to toxic levels is a constant safety threat. Monitoring chemical fumes and recording data about fumes is crucial. Highway Transport's internal IT staff collaborates with Honeywell RAE monitor company. To make sure Highway goes above and beyond industry expectations, Highway's IT programmer Jack Hines has created an online version of our confined space entry process. This new application helps our company move toward paperless features. Simply put, shuffling paper near tank wash zones can become cumbersome. The online process is neater, more efficient. This new workflow is one extra way Highway Transport goes beyond industry expectations to keep equipment accurate, facilities in compliance, and most importantly, keep everyone safe.






